She discussed the importance of saving, the difference between wants and needs, and how to pay yourself first. The students were attentive and participated by sharing information about their own experiences.

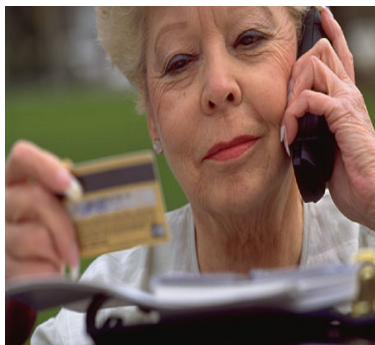
